- I'm the only staff person with weekly KDRT time (about 1/3 FTE)
- ensure compliance with FCC rules
- compliance with other regulations- like DMCA
- compliance with DMA rules & facility rules
- oversee programming decisions / scheduling

Broadcaster Competency

On-Air Broadcaster Competency Checklist for KDRT 95.7 fm

All on-air broadcasters (programmers) must demonstrate competency in each of the following steps before being allowed to do a live radio show in KDRT master broadcast studio.

Demonstration of competencies will be complete when an evaluator has signed off the completion of each step, and Jeff Shaw has signed at the very bottom of the out of order.

Only after all competencies have been initialed will new progr

5. Trainee must participate with a Trainer (Shadowing) in at least programming to hone broadcasting skills.

Trainee must demonstrate the ability to share on-air breaks with Trainer during a one-hour section of KDRT and verbal cues for each break. Specifically, this includes discussion and demonstrated understand and basic broadcasting principles, such as when to break, composition of breaks, and show p

- The Legal ID should occur at the top of the hour and contains station name, optional free
- Breaks should occur every 2-4 songs/every 10-20 mins, in the following order:
 - o Logo
 - Back-announce or topic/quest description
 - "Business" (PSA, etc.)
 - Pre-announce

Program, jock, and station ID

- Talk-ups and talk-downs should occur over instrumental selections/sections only; if
- of instrumental pieces and intros/outros used as beds); jocks should not stop a track before it's over and should not pot down (lower the
- (with vocals) to talk (over the vocals), etc.
- Phrasing should be inclusive and imply continuity.
 - Jocks should use "we" statements (as opposed to "I" statements).

Jocks should refrain from "leaving" statements, such as "be right back." (The station isn't going anywhere.)



Trainee must describe the facility policy regarding harassment and the disciplinary process for violating facility and on-air rules.

Trainee must be added to the KDRT DJ email list and demonstrate understanding of email protocol.

2. Trainee must know and understand all FCC rules and regulations regarding live radio broadcast on an assigned non-commercial frequency.

Trainee must read the KDRT Training Manual (explaining station policy on promotional and commercial speech, prices, and obscenity) in advance, allowing adequate time for questions.

Trainee must show ability to use and edit KDRT website, kdrt.org and send one 10. email to KDRT Programmer email listserve.

Trainee must demonstrate knowledge of user ID, ability to log in to KDRT.org. Must edit show listing, edit • Musical tracks should be allowed to play in entirety, at normal full volume, without bio. upload images, make a blog post announcing new show, and, if a music show, complete a "practice" playlist, and send links of completed work to jeff@davismedia.org. Must send an introductory message to KDRT DJ list.

Audio and video operations augment and compliment each other

- music performances
- talk show audio broadcast / podcast
- live election coverage, forums
- station identity/personality, promotion, & fundraising
- diverse formats = healthier media ecosystem for future platform changes
- Formats can target specific audiences (car drivers, those with accessibility needs, social media)
- add extra content to existing programs-"if you are curious, more info..."
- additional income source- audio or podcast production
- internal operations: training, communication, record keeping

"Jazz After Dark" podcast

- Began weekly show in 2010, now just over 600 episodes
- Registered show with iTunes from the start
- Picked up very early by podcast directories (prob scraped iTunes)
- Player FM (never heard of it): >19,000 subscribers, #1 jazz show on that site for several years
- In Apple Podcast, now Jazz After Dark is within the top 2
 - 5 search results for `jazz'
- As of November 2022, most episodes now get hits from over 100 countries
- Top 5 typically United States, Canada, UK, Japan (always in top 5), then Germany, France, Taiwan, Australia, China, Russia, Ireland. Very small #'s from a lot of countries.

- model not just for broadcast- streams like KVMRx, XRAY.fm, BFF.fm
- KDRT departments borrowed directly from typical community radio station operation (*programming, engineering, public affairs, music, production, outreach, promotions/publicity*)
- Fund drive 2 times / year, + fundraisers throughout
- Empower producers whenever possible

Empower producers whenever possible

- Designate shared space / bring in guests (but have clear guest policy)
- Invest in volunteer driven efforts (for us- "Remote broadcasts" - Davis Music Festival, Monthly Art About, live recordings)







Empower producers whenever possible

- Allow volunteers to develop station "personality" (graphics, schwag...)
- produce events (host touring musicians)
- participate in decision making (Operations Committee / Department Head, Board of Directors)





Build & facilitate community within producer pool

- annual BBQ on the backlot during summer, holiday open house during winter, picnic day parade
- Facilitate / build information sharing amongst volunteers- social media, google groups & drive permissions, meeting space itself
- fundraising efforts / donation drives /week long intensive efforts (visit each other's shows, social media promotion of each other, etc.)
- Require evaluation of other shows, on-air promotion of other shows
- facilitate skill sharing how to do interviews, using field recording equipment, audio production / editing
